National Society of Professional Surveyors – Spring Report Tim Brewer, NSPS Director April 27, 2023

National Society of Professional Surveyors held its Spring Business Meeting in Arlington, Virginia. There were meeting attendance was 257 members that participated in the meetings. The Young Surveyors Network had in excess of 40 members attend. The 2022 Student Competition consisted of 11 teams, while 24 teams competing in the 2023 Student Competition.

The Day on the Hill was represented by 41 states and the District of Columbia, consisting of over 100 participants. There were 157 meetings with Senators and Representatives or staffers. The three issues that action was requested were as follows:

FEMA, NFIP & Flood Insurance Mapping Reform

- Representatives were asked to cosponsor the bill.
- Senators were asked to sponsor a companion bill to the House legislation
- 2023 Farm Bill: Broadband Mapping Reforms Enhancing Infrastructure Deployment
 - Representatives and Senators were asked to co-sponsor legislation, the Base Mapping Act to provide for the RUS, NTIA, and FCC to reduce or eliminate the Digital Divide
- Survey Licensure Protects Public Health, Safety, & Welfare
 - NSPS respectfully urges members of Congress to sponsor a "sense of the Congress" resolution highlighting the important role licensing of surveyors, architects, and engineers play in protecting the public health, safety, and welfare

The newly elected officers were installed during the Board Meeting. There were three members of the Executive Committee elected from nominations from the Board of Directors: Jeff Clendenning – Alabama, Tim Murphy – Illinois, and Tim Brewer – Mississippi. Linda Foster, NSPS Director from South Dakota, was voted the Key Director for the meeting. Matt Morris, NSPS Director from Montana, was elevated to the status of Fellow Member.

As chair of the Membership Committee, I was able to introduce two additional membership categories: Certified Survey Technician (CST) Membership and a Technician Membership. The committee is working through the process with other committees to set the membership guidelines for these categories.

A motion by the Certified Flood Plain Surveyors Board (NFS) committee presented a motion to establish a National Floodplain Surveyors Board. The Board will consist of a seven (7) member CFS Board as follows: Four (4) NSPS Members and alternates: Bart Crattie, GA (three year term) James Craddock, NC (three year term) John Chagnon, ME (two year term) Cliff Baker, AK (two year term) Alternates: James Hollandsworth, MI; Mark Condodemetraky, NH; Ed O'Brien, RI.

As NSPS Membership Committee Chair, I was invited to address the Arkansas Society of Professional Surveyors Board of Directors and Membership meetings to provide an NSPS Update and encourage participation in the 100% Membership Initiative, along with officiating the installation of the 2023-2024 Officers and Board of Directors, at the Spring Conference.

FIG 2023 Working Week will be hosted by NSPS and held in in Orlando, Florida May 27 -June 3. The last occurrence of this event in the United States was 2002.

The 2023 NSPS Fall Business Meeting will be held in Cleveland, Ohio September 19-22.

The 2024 NSPS Spring Business Meeting and Day on the Hill will be held April 23-27 in Arlington, VA.
